THE EPISTLE LESSON: 1 Peter 1:3-21

The holy Scriptures, given first through the prophets, were written for our learning that grace should come to us. In genuine faith we discipline our minds and hope fully in the grace of God. We turn away from the lusts of this world and live holy lives to the glory of God knowing that the most holy God redeemed us, not with silver or gold but with the precious blood of Christ.
