THE EPISTLE LESSON: Hebrews 10:1-14

The Old Testament sacrifices could not actually take anyone's sins away. Therefore the prophets taught that when the Savior would come He would possess a physical body for the purpose of being the real sacrifice that saves. Jesus fulfilled that will of God by being the one offering that makes us holy, once for all; one offering for all people, for all sin, for all time! By that one offering our salvation has been made complete forever.

THE PASSION HISTORY: Trial before Pilate & Herod

Before Pilate Jesus was accused of many things, but Jesus didn't respond to these false accusations. Then Jesus was sent across town to Herod who hoped to see Jesus do some miracle, but again Jesus stood before Herod in silence, and Herod's guard ridiculed Jesus and dressed Him in a gorgeous robe and returned Jesus to Pilate. Pilate tried to secure Jesus' release by putting Him up against Barabbas a known murderer, for receiving the Passover pardon. The people called for Barabbas to be set free and for Jesus to be crucified!
