To this point they have provided immediate aid and housing to our HCLCN members who have suffered loss. The next step will be to build temporary buildings to protect the members during the monsoon season which is now upon them. Once that is over they will begin the work of rebuilding permanent structures. Please continue to keep our brethren in your prayers, as well as the people of Nepal as a whole. This tragedy is an opportunity for our fellow believers to share the hope that is in them with their unbelieving neighbors. May the Lord bless their witness to them!
