CLC NEWS: Immanuel Engineering Design: Over the years many of our Immanuel graduates have gone on to successful engineering careers, also using their God-given skills while serving in our congregations. This year Prof. Jeff Schierenbeck is volunteering to teach a new informal high school class called, "Making - An Introduction to Engineering Design." It will meet one period per week for one semester. The class will involve learning 2D and 3D CAD, CNC production and 3D printing, and microcontroller programming with Arduino. The semester will culminate in student design/build projects which utilize the skills and tools learned about during the semester. The class will be offered in a 'flipped' format in which the students will watch 30-40 minutes of instructional video online followed by a classroom project based on the skills taught in the video.
