THE RESPONSIVE INTROIT: (Psalm 4 selected verses) Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness! You have relieved me in my distress; Have mercy on me, and hear my prayer. <sup>3</sup>But know that the Lord has set apart for Himself him who is godly; The Lord will hear when I call to Him. <sup>5</sup>Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, And put your trust in the Lord. <sup>6</sup> There are many who say, "Who will show us any good?" Lord, lift up the light of Your countenance upon us. <sup>7</sup> You have put gladness in my heart, More than in the season that their grain and wine increased. <sup>8</sup> I will both lie down in peace, and sleep; For You alone, O Lord, make me dwell in safety. Glory be to the Father...

#### OLD TESTAMENT LESSON: Deuteronomy 11:18-21, 26-28

It is easy to take a rather casual approach to the God's Word in our homes and in life in general. The Lord is very serious about His Word and strongly encourages that we pay attention to His Word every day, and that we make sure it is remembered in our homes, and learned by our children. Paying attention to God's Word, receiving it accompanied by faith will bring the Lord's blessing. Neglecting and rejecting His Word brings His curse.

## THE EPISTLE LESSON: Romans 3:21-25a, 27, 28

What is revealed to us in both the Old and new Testaments is nothing less than the righteousness which comes to us through faith in Christ Jesus. We are justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus. That is true no matter who you are, what color your skin, or what language you speak. There is no difference. God justifies the one who has faith in Jesus.
