# THE OLD TESTAMENT LESSON: Genesis 22:1-18

What a test of faith and love Abraham faced when God asked him to offer his son Isaac! Abraham proceeded in faith, trusting God to deliver. The Lord did provide a sacrifice to take Isaac's place, and so the Lord provided the sacrifice to save us also in Jesus our Sacrifice for sin.

THE PASSION LESSON: Trial and Denial in the House of Caiaphas Many came and falsely accused Jesus of crimes others have done, of sins we have done. Truly the Lord laid on Him the iniquity of us all!" At the same time Peter placed himself in the way of temptation, and fell into the sin of denying the Lord repeatedly even with curses. How much we also need a Savior who delivers us from the worst of sins.
