THE RESPONSIVE INTROIT: (Psalm 3:1-4, 8 NKJV) ^{1.} Lord, how they have increased who trouble me! **Many are they who rise up against me.** ² Many are they who say of me, "There is no help for him in God." ³ But You, O Lord, are a shield for me, **My glory and the One who lifts up my head.** ⁴ I cried to the Lord with my voice, **And He heard me from His holy hill.** ^{8.} Salvation belongs to the Lord. **Your blessing is upon Your people.** *Glory be to the Father...*

THE OLD TESTAMENT LESSON: Zechariah 13:7-9

Zechariah prophesies of Jesus' death and the impact the events surrounding His death would have on His disciples, and ultimately upon all who would believe. Yes, they would experience distress and their faith would be tested, but in the end the LORD will say, "This *is* My people"; and each one us will say, "The LORD *is* my God." This is the personal relationship we have with God through faith in Christ Jesus.

THE GOSPEL LESSON: Luke 9:18-24

An important element of faith is a proper understanding of who Jesus is. He is the Christ of God! As such it was necessary for our salvation that Jesus be taken by His enemies and that He suffer and die, and the third day rise again. We must hold on to this truth at all costs.
