The CLC Board of Missions has **called Pastor Rob Sauers** of Luther Memorial, Fond du Lac, WI to serve as the CLC's third **foreign missionary**.

The CLC Call Committee for Educational Institutions extended a call to **Pastor Wayne Eichstadt**, Gethsemane, Spokane, WA. to serve as **professor at Immanuel Lutheran College** in Eau Claire, WI. This call is for replacing Prof. Paul Sullivan who plans to retire in June of 2020.

Joint Mission Festival Service This year the Minnesota Conference of the CLC will be hosting a Joint Mission Festival at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Mankato, MN on October 20 at 4pm.
